

Uniform System of Assessment and Examination from Academic year 2019 – 20 onwards

The assessment structure and examination for all classes in CBSE have been prepared in view of the provisions of RTE – Act 2009 comprising two terms. Term I & II consist of 100 Marks each.

Term I	20 Marks of Periodic Assessment (Internals) + 80 Marks of Half Yearly Exam
Term II	20 Marks of Periodic Assessment (Internals) + 80 Marks of Yearly Exam
